Installation Information

Products included with the March 2007 release of Synopsys software require the complete installation procedure. Install each version in a new directory. Do not install different versions of Synopsys software in the same directory. Also, do not install these versions of the software over an earlier release.

For installation instructions for most Synopsys tools, see the *product_INSTALL_README.txt* file in the product download directory. For detailed installation instructions, see the *Installation Guide*, which is available at <http://www.synopsys.com/install> and in the “Installing Synopsys Software” section of SOLD.

For product-specific issues not covered by these release notes, see the release notes for individual products.

Limitations

This section describes limitations and workarounds for Synopsys Installer versions 1.5 and 1.6 and a documentation limitation for Synopsys Common Licensing.

Using Synopsys Installer versions 1.5 and 1.6 on Sun Solaris Platforms

On Sun Solaris platforms, Synopsys Installer might freeze or issue a failed report after you verify the checksum.

Workaround

To work around this problem, run the installer on a different platform, such as Linux. This problem will be fixed in a future release.

Using Synopsys Installer versions 1.5 and 1.6 on the Andrew File System

If you are installing a Synopsys tool to an Andrew File System (AFS) mounted partition, the installer might fail when checking for disk space.

Workaround

To work around this problem, install to a local file system or a Network File System (NFS) mounted partition. This problem will be fixed in a future release.

Synopsys Common Licensing Version

The Synopsys Common Licensing (SCL) instructions in the Z-2007.03 Installation Guide specify that you must install SCL 10.9.1. However, later versions are recommended. For detailed information, see the Synopsys Licensing QuickStart Guide at
